We have two more high school games and one more for middle school. We need to get some more volunteers. We spent 1400 on masks; we are \$300 in the red. We have all sizes left. The least quantity is the small/medium. We also can sell at basketball games. The meat sticks are selling with concessions but we have five cases to move. We need to decide when to start MoonPies. Discussion occurred.

Band Director's Report: We cannot travel, and we haven't heard about the Knoxville parade. We are going to do the Veterans parade and Dunlap Christmas parade. Junior clinic (March 2021) and All-East (February 2021) will happen but auditions must be online. It is a blind audition (sound). Until we hear more about travel there are very few in person events. We are learning music for a Christmas concert. It would be great December 15, 2020. The last I heard on the truck was that the bid was sent out but it was not bidded? That needs to be followed up on soon.

Student Report: Sidney added that the marching band is practicing for a modified homecoming parade.

New Business: Mr. Willis would like to add the jazz band to the Christmas concert. We are looking at a bigger trip for our concert band in 2022 (perhaps the Heritage Festival). Universal and Disney do an "Art of Foley." It is like a clinic with movie soundtrack compositions. Then they record the students playing with the film.
